

Declaration

I Ellen Kinchington of 90 Northumberland road Ceburne New South Wales do solemnly and sincerely declare that - -

1 I am the mother of Robert Emmett Kinchington No 2875 D Company 3rd Battalion Australian Imperial Forces on active service abroad. - -

2. My said son Robert Emmett Kinchington enlisted at Victoria Barracks Sydney in or about the month of June 1916 under the name of George Ernest Kinchington in the 6th Reinforcements 1st Australian Pioneers.

3. I hereby request that the military records may be amended so that his true name Robert Emmett Kinchington may appear on the said records instead of the name under which he enlisted as before mentioned, And I make this solemn declaration conscientiously believing the same to be true, and by virtue of the provisions of the Oaths Act 1901. - -
